Interspersed throughout the seminar attendees learn 10 parenting strategies that they can use to deal with common problems of parenting from a heart-based perspective. Using the concept of conscience development, parents focus on four areas where children often have negative patterns.

Doing What's Right

Parents can help their children learn to be internally motivated. However, they must move away from anger, threats and bribes as they are working with their kids. Clear strategies are taught that help parents develop an action plan to move their children from where they are to where they need to be.

Dealing With Wrongs

Instead of blaming, excusing, or manipulating with anger, children need to learn to respond well to correction. After all, correction is a teaching tool. When parents learn the correction strategies taught in this seminar, kids have a better plan for responding to offenses that's good not only now, but also for the rest of their lives. These ideas alone dramatically reduces friction in homes.

Being Honest

A third area of conscience development has to do with honesty. Some children struggle with this more than others but all kids need to value integrity. The conscience is a God-given motivation inside of a child and when parents learn to work in conjunction with it then amazing things happen. Developing a desire for integrity is an important part of growing up.

Caring About Others

As children grow and develop they should be moving away from self-centered thinking to considering others more. The strategies presented in this seminar provide parents with practical tools to help kids think about others and demonstrate compassion.
