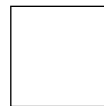
Code Breaker Wheel

Use the Code Breaker Wheel to decode this message.

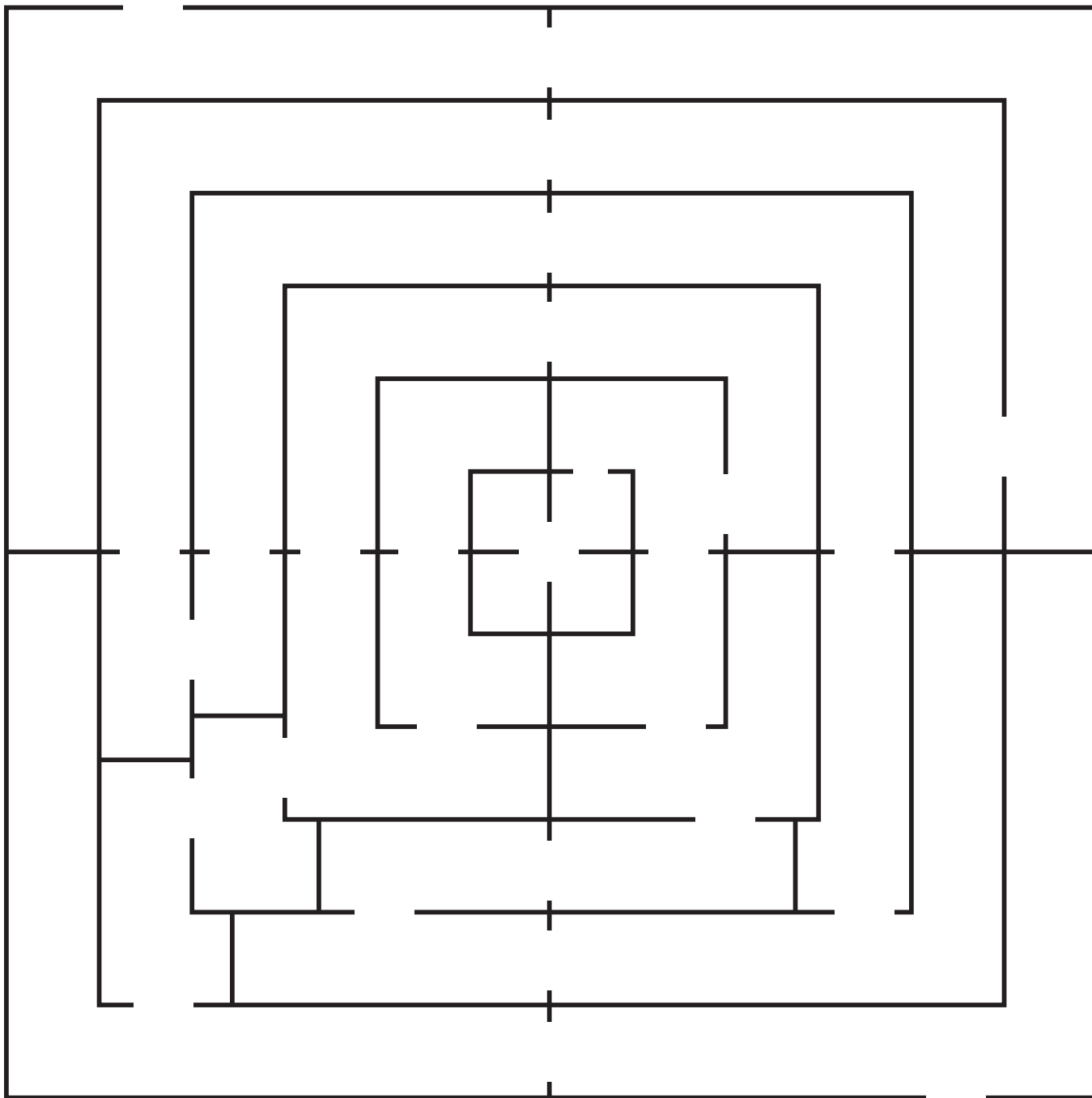
The students will cut out the bottom box and give it to the person along with the Code Breaker wheel.
